To the people of God at Our Redeemer,

Merry Christmas and Happy New Year!! I wish to extend greetings to all our family in Christ during this Christmas Season. During this time of year, we tend to reminisce about the past and look forward to the future. We had a very exciting year at Our Redeemer. I am so thankful we were able to remodel our Sunday School rooms, and I especially want to thank Keith for designing, installing, and maintaining our new sound system. We have been blessed with faithful children of God who have thoughtfully and deliberately given their time, talents, and treasure for the furthering of the Gospel.

As we made plans for these investments in the future of our church, how we would pay for these projects was a question. Heading into these endeavors, it was not clear from where the resources would come. We spent about \$41,000 on remodeling costs. At the end of November we were showing a deficit of \$45,846.25 for the 2012 calendar year. The common response was, "The Lord will provide." And the Lord did provide. Again, this was accomplished through thoughtful and deliberate stewardship. The Lord works through means. Saying "The Lord will provide" does not mean that bags of money will miraculously appear on the doorstep of the church. The Lord provides by inspiring thoughtful and deliberate acts of stewardship among His people.

In the month of December, our church was blessed with two large gifts. Dody Rodefeld divided her estate between seven people or church-related entities including Our Redeemer, and we were blessed to receive \$37,500. The other gift was from Ruth Sprenger's family, who donated 385 shares of Brunswick Corporation stock to Our Redeemer as a memorial in memory of Ruth. The transaction has yet to be settled as of December 21, but the stock is trading for \$28 per share which values the gift at \$10,780.

In looking at our need and the Lord's response, I am reminded of Christ's words in His Sermon on the Mount, "for your Father knows what you need before you ask Him" [Mt. 6:8]. During this time of year as we reminisce about the past and look forward to the future, I am also reminded of St. Paul's words, "For if we live, we live to the Lord, and if we die, we die to the Lord. So then, whether we live or whether we die, we are the Lord's" [Rom 14:8].

In life and in death, each day being a gift from God, we have the opportunity to serve our Lord and benefit the spread of the Gospel through thoughtful and deliberate stewardship. Last year was an exciting year. 2013 will be also as we continue to share the Gospel and further the Kingdom of God through the ministry of Our Redeemer.




