LWML annual rummage sale August 20 and 21. Mark your calendars and start collecting and organizing usable items you no longer need. No TVS. We will announce a date in a couple weeks when you can start delivering items to the church. Thanks to everyone who have helped us raise over \$13,000 in the last six years. All of this for missions! Thanks again. Let's keep up the Lord's work!!

Request for Suggestions from the Congregation ORLC has received a federal payroll tax refund of \$8,926.15 due to a law passed last March as a result of the Covid crisis. The Church Council is considering what to do with this unexpected income, and would like to hear ideas from the Congregation before making a recommendation to the Voters Assembly at the Sept. 26th Meeting. The ideas being considered so far are:

Just keep the money in the general fund for future needs; Pay it into the ORLC St. James School Endowment Fund; Donate it to selected mission project or charity such as the St. John's Food Pantry, the Quincy Neighborhood Federation, or similar entity; Provide additional assistance to the church in Uganda, or others in need; Divide the total amount and allocate it to two or more of such entities.

If you have an idea for good use of the funds, please communicate it to a member of the Church Council **before its next meeting on Aug. 18**. At that meeting the Council will consider the issue and what to **recommend to the Voters on Sept, 26**, at which time the Voters will make the final decision. 
