To the people of God at Our Redeemer,

One of the great gifts in the church which strengthens and educates while bringing joy, peace, and comfort is the hymnal. The obvious value of the hymnal is seen in the hymns sung in worship. We are privileged to have access to the best hymns ever written. The beauty of old hymns is not simply that they are traditional. Old hymns which have stood the test of time tend to be important. Only important things stand the test of time. Most music is quickly forgotten.

Within the hymnal is also the liturgy of the church. The historic Divine Service has been modified over the years, however, the basic structure has been consistent with the Invocation, Confession and Absolution, Service of the Word, Service of the Sacrament, and Benediction. Within the liturgy, God speaks through Scripture and the story of Christ is told from the angels singing "Glory to God in the Highest" at His birth to the crowd on Palm Sunday singing "Hosanna in the Highest! Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord!"

Starting on page 268 in the Lutheran Service Book, we see the Rites which shepherd us through our days in the church. We begin with the Rite of Holy Baptism followed by the Rite of Confirmation as we confirm the faith of our Baptism. We confess the faith which our godparents spoke on our behalf in our youth. Turning the page brings us the Rite of Holy Matrimony and the vow of marital fidelity until death parts us. Turning the page again brings us to the Funeral Service and the remembrance of our Baptism as the funeral pall is placed upon our casket and we hear the words of St. Paul, "Do you not know that all of us who have been baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into His death?" To which the congregation responds, "We were buried therefore with Him by baptism into death, in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might walk in newness of life. For if we have been united with Him in a death like His, we shall certainly be united with Him in a resurrection like His."

Within the hymnal we find Luther's Small Catechism, many of the Psalms, prayers for all occasions, and on the very front page we find the Prayers for Worship. You may notice more than a few at Our Redeemer will have this page open before worship or before or after receiving the sacrament. There are seven prayers printed which are well crafted, appropriate, meaningful prayers. I encourage you to utilize these tools. If I was told that I was being sent to a desert island and could only take the Bible and one other book, that book would be the hymnal.
