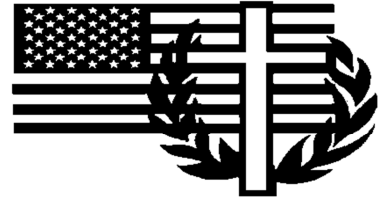

We are looking for items to help in our decorations for the *Big Jungle Adventure* VBS. We would like to borrow the following:

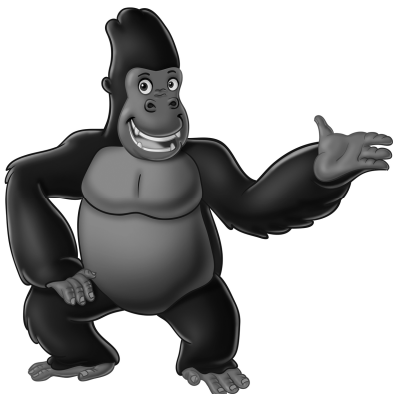
- **Jungle Animals (monkeys, lions, giraffes – oh my!)** We need a few for our stage area. Please label your animal.
