ACHIEVEMENT TEST RESULTS – In April, our kindergarten – 8th grade students took the Stanford Achievement Tests. These tests are used as a tool to help determine curriculum needs and gives information about how our students compare to other students nationally in academic achievement. St. James students as a whole (average) scored better than 72% of students around our nation of the same age and time when the tests were administered. (Any score above the 50th percentile is considered better than average.) We are proud of their accomplishments and the skilled, dedicated teachers that help our students achieve at this level.
