**ACHIEVEMENT TEST RESULTS** – In April, our kindergarten –  $8^{th}$  grade students took the Stanford Achievement Tests. These tests are used as a tool to help determine curriculum needs and gives information about how our students compare to other students nationally in academic achievement. St. James students as a whole (average) scored better than 72% of students around our nation of the same age and time when the tests were administered. (Any score above the 50<sup>th</sup> percentile is considered better than average.) We are proud of their accomplishments and the skilled, dedicated teachers that help our students achieve at this level.
