Regional Youth Conference "The Holy Spirit and Pentecost"

On Saturday April 27th from 9:00 am to 6:30 pm, the congregations of Faith and Zion in Lincoln will be hosting a Regional Youth Conference. The theme is "The Holy Spirit and Pentecost".
