Greetings pastors, parents, and youth leaders in the CID, NID, or SID

On Saturday April 27th from 9:00 am to 6:30 pm, the congregations of Faith and Zion in Lincoln will be hosting a Regional Youth Conference. The theme is *"The Holy Spirit and Pentecost"*. This spring we will be learning about whom the Holy Spirit is, what His particular work is, and what the day of Pentecost is all about. We will also be talking about problems with Pentecostalism, the importance of the Means of Grace, the Word of God and the Holy Spirit, and what "speaking in tongues" truly is. At the conference, presentations and sectionals on these and other topics will be led by local pastors and lay leaders.
