### ST. JAMES SCHOOL....

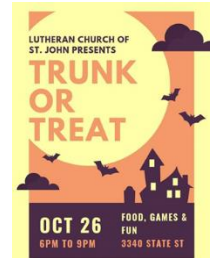
- still teaches cursive handwriting and Spelling.
