We will have a brief **Voters' Meeting** immediately after service on **Sunday, August 23**. The Church Council is recommending an expenditure not to exceed \$13,000 for a split heating and air conditioning system for the Pastor's office, Church Lounge, and Choir room. Each area will be in a separate zone which will allow us to control these areas independently. The recommended expenditure will cover the low bid from Keck Heating and Air Conditioning, and any incidental wiring/miscellaneous expense to complete the work. If you haven't called ahead to reserve a spot in today's Church service and attended church in person, please make sure you sign the sheet in the Narthex. WE ARE REQUIRED to keep a list of those attending in case someone contracts COVID-19 and other attendees need to be notified by the church.

Given the recent outbreak of COVID-19 in Adams County, the health department has asked that we step up security measures to prevent further spread. Wanting to be good stewards, Pastor Eden and the Elders strongly encourage that everyone wear a mask while inside the building, even when singing. We know that the sound will not be great but we are still praising God and He will hear it. Pastor Eden will not wear a mask during the actual service so that he will be able to effectively communicate. The service bulletins will be placed on tables where people can pick them up themselves. Please take them home and recycle them. Also, we encourage everyone to socially distance before and after services. Interacting with our church family is important, but for now, we ask that you carry on your conversations preferably outside and at a **distance**. It is painfully aware to all of our church leaders that much of what we ask is inconvenient. However, we are doing all that we can to ensure that we can keep our people safe and have active worship here at Our Redeemer. We will continue to broadcast on Facebook Live. We will continue to have our Wednesday 10:00 AM Bible Class and 11:30 AM Communion Service. Please join us whenever and however you can.
