Pastor Eden and the Elders have decided to move forward with gradually returning to pre-COVID practices. We ask for your grace and patience as we know that we are moving faster than some would like and slower than others would like. The following are the planned changes and when they will take place:

April 10 & 11: Hymnals will be in the pews and used during the Divine Service. They will not be disinfected inbetween services. If you desire to bring your own hymnal, you may purchase one to keep or check one out from the office.

April 17 & 18: Masks will still be worn entering and exiting the sanctuary but may be removed while sitting in the pew. This has been the common practice at many churches since the pandemic has eased. We will, of course, make changes as needed.

June 5 & 6: Traditional communion distribution style with individual and common cup. We will still be relatively socially distant with groups or individuals while lining up in the aisle and kneeling at the rail. At this time, the plan is for the pastor and communion assistants to wear masks during distribution.
