Request for Ideas from the Congregation

ORLC has received a federal payroll tax refund of \$8,926.15 due to a law passed last March as a result of the Covid crisis. The Church Council is considering what to do with this unexpected income, and would like to hear ideas from the Congregation before making a recommendation at the next Voters Meeting. Among the ideas being considered are:

Just keep the money in the general fund for future needs; Pay it into the ORLC St. James School Endowment Fund; Donate it to selected mission project or charity such as the St. John's Food Pantry, the Quincy Neighborhood Federation, or similar entity; Provide additional assistance to the church in Uganda, or others in need; Divide the total amount and allocate it to two or more of such entities.

If you have an idea for good use of the funds, please communicate it to a member of the Church Council before August 18. At that meeting the Council will consider the issue and what to recommend to the Voters on September 26, at which time the Voters will make the final decision. SENIOR (OLDER ADULT) RETREAT Southern Illinois District and the Missouri District will hold the 19th Lutheran Older Adult Retreat on **October 20 (Wednesday) and October 21 (Thursday)** at the Pere Marquette Lodge & Conference Center in Grafton, II.
