**Town Hall September 27** Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod is excited to invite you to attend a virtual Synod-wide town hall to kick off the next stage of the Set Apart to Serve (SAS) church work recruitment initiative. **Join us online Wednesday, September 27, from 1 to 2 p.m. Central time.** More information will be coming soon. SAS is a collaborative effort across the Synod to support and encourage future church workers. Our goal is to create an intentional culture of church worker formation in every LCMS congregation, Lutheran school, and camp. We are developing resources and tools to help congregations foster this culture. During the past five and a half months, we have worked with 36 congregations, schools, and camps that represent all 35 LCMS districts to pilot-test these SAS resources and tools. Feedback from the pilot sites has helped us refine these resources, and now we are excited to share these effective toolkits with you. During the town hall, we will:

- Provide a brief overview of SAS;
- Share what we learned working with the pilot participants;
- Introduce resources and tools to help congregations, schools, and camps with raising up the next generation of church workers; and

**Moonlight Ride for Hunger Saturday, Augusts 26, 2023** Have you ever wanted to ride your bike across both our Quincy Bridges? The Moonlight Ride for Hunger is a family-friendly community event that benefits the Horizons Soup Kitchen and Food Pantry. The ride begins with a four-mile trek across both of the bridges in Quincy, with an optional extended route that takes you up the Bill Klingner Bike Trail and back again for a total of 12 miles. The Moonlight Ride for Hunger is an annual event to raise money for Horizons Soup Kitchen and Food Pantry. As you know, our team here at Horizons feeds over 32,000 people in our food pantry and serve over 50,000 meals through our kitchen each year. Located at 224 South 8th Street in Quincy, IL, our ministry is at the epicenter of the need of impoverished people in Adams County. Registration is required for all events and 100% of all proceeds (after expenses) from the Moonlight Ride for Hunger go to Horizons for use in our outreach to the needy in Quincy and the surrounding area! Individuals **registering before August 10th** will get a free Moonlight Ride t-shirt. Please note that the registration fee for the Adult Bike Ride increases to \$40 if you wait until the day of the race to register. **Online registration ends on August 25th**, after which you will need to register at Madison Davis or at the event itself.
