UPDATE Inkjet Cartridge Recycling: We have had an overflowing response to the ink cartridge recycling project. Recently, 106 cartridges were donated to the collection box at church and mailed off to Planet Green Recycling. We will be receiving a check for \$88.75 for our recycling efforts! Those funds will be sent to the Uganda Mission! This is in addition to the \$12.75 check that we received earlier this year. Each cartridge is examined for it's value. Even the ones which they cannot use and refill we will receive 25 cents each for our effort. Your combined efforts of simply recycling your inkjet cartridges will result in a larger sum being sent to Uganda. Here are ways you can help:
